RICE TOWNSHIP HOUSE:

In December 2016, after a few months of having the old Rice Township house on the corner at SR19 & CR119 up for sale (removal only), with some interest shown, the trustees unanimously voted to demolish the building. The decision was due to the need for numerous costly repairs.

NOTIFICATIONS:

Rice Township now has a website! Website will be used for all public and legal notices to township residents. Meeting dates and times will be posted on this website, as well as any public notice. Residents will be able to view information on zoning, cemeteries, township personnel, and our contact information. Visit our website www.ricetownship.com. Let us know what you think.

All meetings and public notices will be posted on the bulletin board in front of Rice Township Maintenance Building at 142 CR 119. Rice Township Trustees are going to post all events and notices on board and website, opposed to publishing in local newspaper which costs the township \$182 per month. These options are more cost effective.

We are adding on! Rice Township has been awarded the Local Government Safety Capital Grant. Funds will be used to add on to the maintenance building to have a fire station operated by Lindsey Volunteer Fire within Rice Township. The grant will enable faster response times, emergency shelters, reduce risk for residents and firefighters, community safety incentives, and economic benefits to residents and businesses. Having the fire station in Rice Township can help residents and businesses save on homeowners insurance since a station is within a 5 mile radius. Total cost of the addition project is \$289,942 which is split between the state and township. Rice Township, its partners, and donations make up 45% of total cost. Rice Township has committed \$100,000 to addition project, Village of Lindsey pledged \$12,500, Washington Township pledged \$12,500, Lindsey Volunteer Fire pledged \$2,000, The Fraternal Order of Eagles in Fremont, Ohio and Aerie #712 donated \$2,000, FO Energy LLC pledged \$1,500 toward building addition. The remaining amount of \$159,442 will be paid by the state.

Rice Township now has 2 meetings per month, on the first and third Mondays of the month at 7:00 p.m.

Rice Township has a full time recycle program with recycle containers located at the Rice Township Maintenance Building, 142 CR 119. Residents may take their recycle items to the containers at their convenience, not just on the third Saturday of each month. Recycle items need not be separated. Recycle information is shown on the front of the recycle containers.

Aluminum & Steel Cans:

Rinse thoroughly. Includes empty aerosol cans (with lids and tips removed). NO Hangers, pots or pans.

Glass Bottles & Jars Only:

Rinse Thoroughly. Remove Lids. NO Window glass, dishes or cookware, drinking glasses, light bulbs, mirrors, ceramic or china.

& #3 - #7 Containers Rinse - Containers should be empty or without liquids. NO plastic bags, motor oil containers, buckets, Styrofoam, toys, butter tubs, etc. Remove Lids.

Plastics: ALL #1 - #2 Plastics

Paper: Cardboard, Cartons, Junk Mail, Paperboard, Phone Books

Magazines, Newspaper, Office Paper, Includes phone books & paperback books. NO hard back books.

Remove plastic wrappers from newspapers and magazines. Leave advertisement inserts in newspapers.

Cartons for juice, soy milk, milk, broth, cream, egg substitutes (remove caps & straws)

NO. foil pouches

FLATTEN ALL BOXES

Remove all packaging materials: tissue paper, packaging peanuts, Styrofoam, bubble wrap, etc. NO colored construction paper, candy wrappers, tissues, wax coated materials, napkins, hanging or reinforced file folders, copy paper covers, carbon paper, etc.

These recycle containers are for use by the township residence only, NO BUSINESSES.
